A gentle, nearly dry white with fragrance of basil and a refreshing green apple finish. This wine is a unique, gentle white that is increasingly popular with every taste. Pairs well with salads, chicken, sweet and sour foods, and stir-fry.

❖ **Grape:** 100% White Riesling, custom-grown in Washington state

❖ **Production Method:** cold fermentation, natural residual sweetness of 0.5% obtained by stopping fermentation

❖ **Aging:** none, bottled early spring

❖ **Sweetness:** nearly dry

❖ **Alcohol:** 11.5%

❖ **Serving Temperature:** 40° - 45°

❖ **Ageability:** enjoy young (up to two years)

❖ **History:** started making Dry Riesling in 1991
