Carignan Dry Red Wine

Carignan is a dark red wine made in honor of Hungarian Agoston Haraszthy, who planted the first vineyards and dug the back of the hillside cave in the 1840s. This wine was aged in Eastern European oak barrels for about 10 months and has a pleasing palate with notes of cherry and nutmeg.

Grape: 100% Carignan, custom-grown in California Production Method: Crushed, destemmed and fermented on the skins for about 10 days Aging: 9–12 months in Eastern European oak barrels Sweetness: Dry Alcohol: 13.7% Serving Temperature: Cool room temperature Aging Potential: 3-5 years Serve with: Steak, hearty stews History: Started making Carignan in 2013
