Dry Red Wine

An earthy red with hints of plum, made using traditional Burgundian methods. Aged up to a year in French oak barrels for a long, smooth finish.

Grape: 100% Pinot Noir, custom-grown in California

Production Method: Crushed and destemmed, long warm fermentation

Aging: 9-12 months in French oak barrels

Sweetness: Dry Alcohol: 13.6%

Serving Temperature: Cool room temperature

Aging Potential: 3-5 years

Serve with: Game, salmon, trout
